1. History of Corner Establishment and Subsequent Restoration:

Originally set by John Truten during 1857 G.L.O. survey. Restored with 3/4" iron pipe set by Fred Law in 1962 from corner 1 mile west. Pipe replaced by John Lawson, L.S. 11989, in 1981 with 2-1/2" iron pipe. In 1938, B.P.A. found 1-1/2" pipe. In 1949, Hwy. Dept. found 1-1/2" pipe. In 1962, Bert Mason used 3/4" pipe. In 1977, Wallace & Assoc. used 3/4" pipe. (See Book 7 pg. 106) In 1979, Alpha Engineers used 3/4" pipe. (See Book 10 pg. 199)

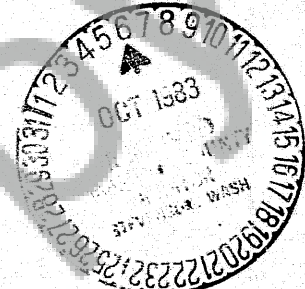
2. Description of Evidence Found:

Above mentioned 2-1/2" iron pipe and stamped brass cap. 3/4" x 36" iron pipe laying alongside Lawson monument. 1-1/2" iron pipe at N 88 W, 125.66 ft. from Lawson monument. Not accepted this survey.

Accepted corner.

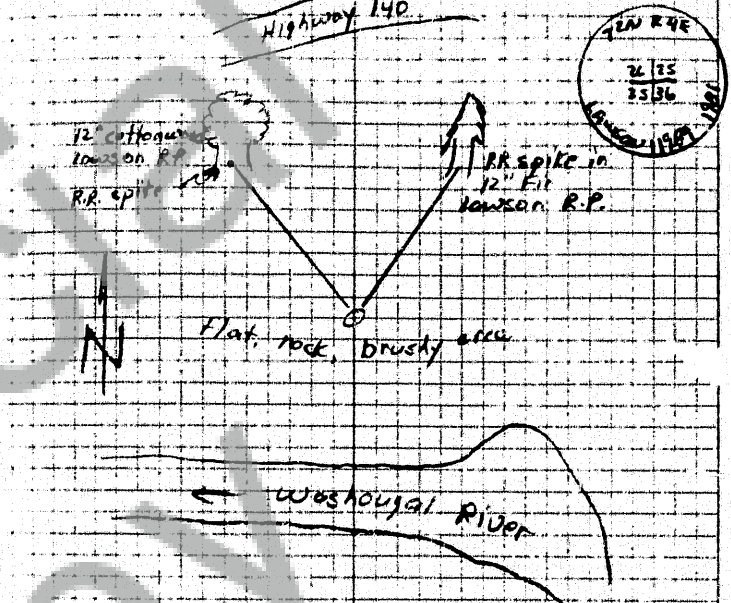

Found 2 1/2" iron pipe w/ brass cap in mound of conc. set by J. Lawson. Pipe sticks up 11". A 3/4" x 36" iron pipe is laying beside mound. The ~~5.00~~ ^{creep coll} 5.00 ch east fits perfectly, as does the 60.50 ch foot of descent coll, which is 20.04 ch west of this corner. The dist. to the S bank of the Washougal (77.00) is within 15' of 610, which is within limits for an even chain coll. We also found a 1 1/2" iron pipe 126' west of Lawsons pipe.
