1. History of Corner Establishment and Subsequent Restoration: 2. Description of Evidence Found:
Section established by GLO in 1892. This corner established by Bert Mason, Jr. in a 1964 survey for establishment of interior property lines. For this corner, Mason set a 3/4" iron pipe, from which:

18" fir, N31W, 25.2 feet to face scribed WC1/16BT

2. Found iron pipe 11" below ground in NW shoulder of Skaar Road.
Found healed witness tree, fits except for bearing. Tree marked with LF Co. witness tag.

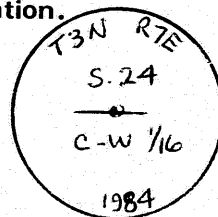
Drove a 1 1/2 x 30" galvanized iron pipe with 2 1/2" brass cap over the 3/4" iron pipe, flush with the ground, in a 12 x 12 x 6" mound of stone, from which bear:

22" D-fir, N07W, 25.33 ft. to nail at center of tree with healed face (scribed WC1/16BT)

(2"IP) Ska. Co. post & tag, N68W, 37.4 feet.

Set a steel fence post next to corner monument.

Brass cap is stamped as shown, and marked with the proper corner identification.

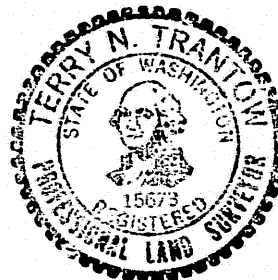
