36" fir stump N. 22° W. 47.3 feet.

36" fir stump N. 64° E. 22.8 feet

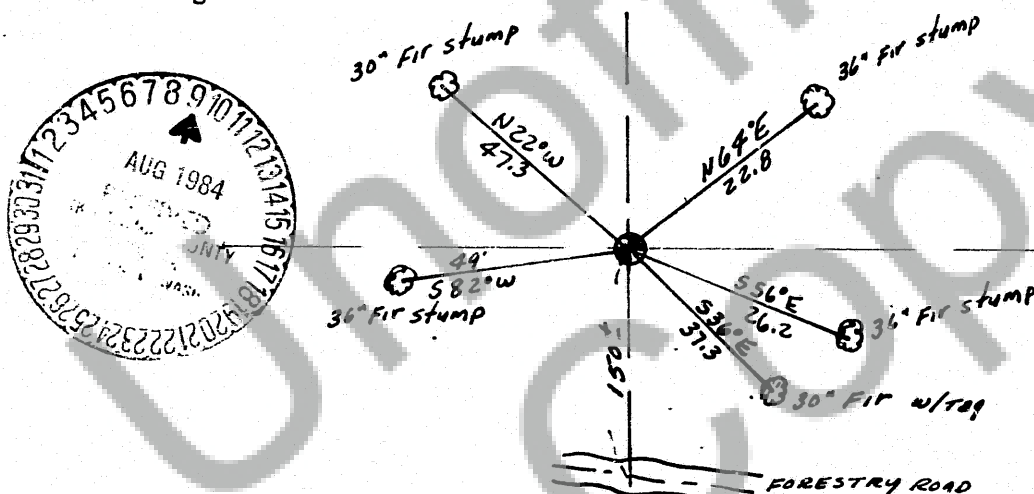
36" fir stump S. 56° E. 26.2 feet

36" fir stump S. 82° W. 49.0 feet

30" fir with tag (nail in root crown gone) S. 36° E. 37.3 feet to center of tree.
