1. History of Corner Establishment and Subsequent Restoration:

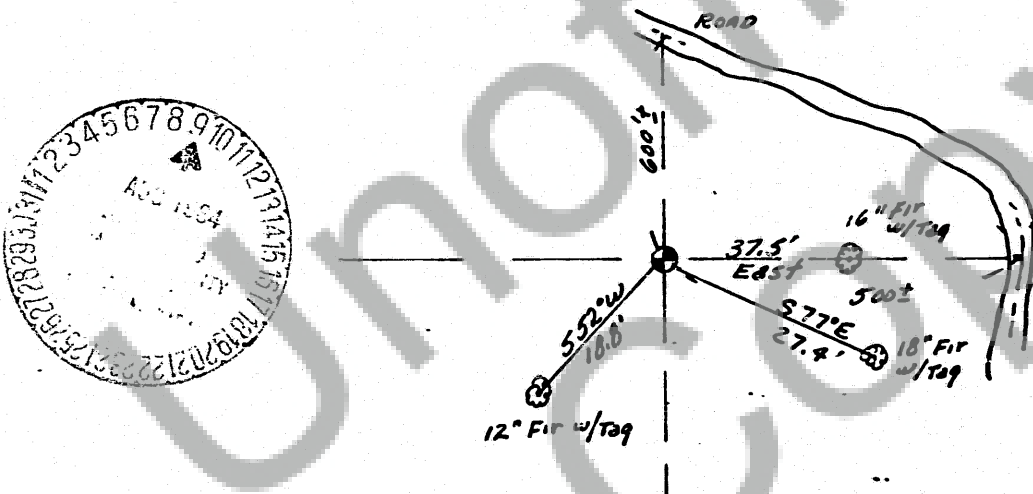
G.L.O. survey by Jacob Richardson in 1883. Set post and four bearing trees
 Re-established by Bert Mason in 1966. Found no original evidence. Reset longitudinally
 by tying 1/4 corners to east and west. Set latitudinally from creek call to
 North and line tree South.
 D.N.R. set monument in 1968 replacing Mason's corner.

2. Description of Evidence Found:

Found D.N.R. concrete monument with stamped brass cap.
 16" fir with D.N.R. tag East 37.5 feet.
 12" fir with tag and healed over blaze S. 52° W. 18.8 feet.
 18" fir with D.N.R. tag S. 77° E. 27.4 feet.
