This Indenture made this first day of June
in the year of our Lord, one thousand and
Eight hundred and ~~and~~ Eighty five between
the Oregon Railway and Navigation Company
a body corporate created, organized and
existing under and by virtue of the Acts of the
Legislature of the State of Oregon party of
the first part. and the Farmers Loan and
Trust Company a Corporation created and
existing under and by virtue of the Laws of
the State of New York party of the
second part.

Witnesseth

Whereas the said party of the first
part is authorized and empowered in and
by its Original and amended Articles of
Incorporation and pursuant to the several
acts of the Legislature of the State of
Oregon as follows:

First. To construct and equip the following
Railroad and Telegraph lines namely: First a
line along the South side of Columbia River
between Portland and Umatilla. Second a line
from Umatilla across the Blue Mountains through
the Grand Round Valley in a southeasterly
direction to a point on the east State Line
of Oregon towards Boise City. Third a line
from Umatilla to Wallula in Washington
Territory by way of Weston southerly to the point
of intersection with the line in Oregon.
Secondly described Fifth from Wallula
in Washington Territory in a northeasterly
direction by Dayton to the Snake River
Sixth from a point on the Snake River
in Washington Territory near the mouth of
the Palouse River along the valley of the Palouse
