Know all men by these presents that we Bolivar B Bishop and Luma Bishop his wife of Luma Tella County Oregon, in consideration of Fifty Dollars to us paid by the Oregon Railway and Navigation Company, do hereby remise release and forever quit claim unto the said ^{sls} Oregon Railway and Navigation Company a Corporation duly Incorporated and qualified to hold real property in Washington Territory and unto its successors and assigns all our right title and Interest in and to the following described parcels of real estate Situate in Skamania County Washington Territory to wit - all and singular the Donation Land Claim of Bolivar B Bishop and Wife Notification numbered 1003 claim numbered thirty nine (39) and being bounded and described as follows to wit -

Beginning at a point four chains west and thirty chains and fifty links north of the southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of said Section sixteen and running thence south sixty chains and eight links thence south eighty six degrees and forty five minutes west eight chains and fifty links thence south fifty seven degrees west thirteen chains and sixty links thence south thirty eight degrees west fifteen chains thence south twenty three degrees and thirty minutes west three chains and eighty links thence south forty five degrees west twenty one chains and fifty links thence north sixty eight chains and thence east forty five chains and ninety four links to the place of beginning in the district of lands subject to sale at Vancouver Washington Territory containing three hundred and twenty acres, and twenty five hundredths of an acre to have and to hold the same to together with all and singular the Hereditments and Appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said the Oregon Railway and Navigation Company its successors, and assigns And witness hereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals, this 4th day of December
