Such expenditure was made at the request and expense of the "Samson Pacific Copper and Gold Mining Company" for the purpose of holding the said claims. Dated Toledo

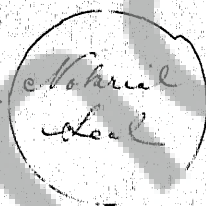
