

This Indenture made this 28th day of April in
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
eighty seven between Christian Ritter of Skamania
County W.T. party of the first part and L.C. Bailey of
Multnomah County Oregon party of the second part.
Witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in
consideration of the sum of One hundred Dollars to me in
hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have bargained sold aliened Released conveyed and
confirmed and by these presents do bargain sell alien
Release convey and confirm unto the said party of the
second part his heirs and assigns forever all that piece
or parcel of land described as follows. North East Quarter of
Section thirty two in Township two North of Range five
East of the Willamette Meridian lying and being
in the County of Skamania in the Territory of Washington
and containing One hundred and Sixty acres.

The conditions of the above indenture is whereas the said
Christian Ritter did on this the 28 day of April 1887
execute his promissory note payable to said
L.C. Bailey for the sum of One hundred Dollars payable
on or before the 28th day of April Ad 1888 a copy of which
note is as follows.

Portland Oregon April 28th 1887

"For Value Received I promise to pay L.C. Bailey
"Or Order the sum of One hundred Dollars with interest
"on same until paid at the Rate of ten percent per
"annum payable on or before the 28th day of April
"A.D. 1888. (Signed) Christian Ritter
