

Notice of Location "Thos Jefferson" Mining Claim.

Notice of Location

To whom it may concern:

Notice is hereby given, that J. K. Manning citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did on the 25th day of January A.D. 1899, locate and by this notice do hereby locate a Quartz Claim, known as the Thos Jefferson Lode or Mining Claim, said claim having been discovered the First day of January 1899, and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lode, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) twenty acres of placer mining ground, situated in Copper Creek Mining District, County of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at discovery and notice on Copper Creek, It runs 1500 feet in a Southerly direction to the Center end stake Thence 300 feet Easterly to the South East corner stake, thence 1500 feet Northerly to the North East Corner stake on Copper Creek. Thence 300 feet down Copper Creek westerly to discovery and notice Thence 300 feet Westerly to the North West Corner stake Thence 1500 feet Southerly to the South West corner stake Thence 300 feet Easterly to the South Center End Stake. This claim joins the George Washington Claim on the West.

And I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the Mining Laws of the United States and of the State of Washington
