I the undersigned having complied with the requirements of Chapter 6 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes of the United States and local customs, laws, and regulations has located 1500 linear feet on a quartz lode known as the "Black Jack" mine situated on Camp Creek Negro head district and described as follows:

I the undersigned who is a citizen of the United States hereby declare and give notice to all persons concerned, that she has discovered a vein or lode within the limits of the claim hereby located and in said lode a vein or series of quartz or ore with at least one well defined wall and that she has this 21st day of August A.D. 1897 located and she hereby locate and claim under and by virtue of Chapter 32, Title 32 of the Revised Statutes of the United States and the laws amendatory thereof.

and the Laws of the State of Washington a mining claim upon said Lode or Vein to be designated and named the "Herbert H." Quartz Lode Mining Claim extending along said Lode or Vein 1500 ft in a Northerly direction from the center of the Discovery shaft (at which shaft this notice and statement is posted) and 300 feet on each side from the middle or center of said Lode or Vein at the surface; comprising in all 1500 feet in length along said Lode or Vein and 600 feet in width with all the rights and privileges as to surface ground and lodes, veins or ledges within the boundaries of said claim and otherwise and the metals minerals and valuable deposits of every kind contained in said veins, lodes or ledges, or within said boundaries which are given or allowed by the laws of the United States aforesaid, or of the State of Washington.

Before me the Subscribes personally appeared G. E. Brown, agent who being duly sworn says that at least \$300 three hundred dollars worth of labor or improvements were performed made upon the "Blue Jacket" and "Hickapoo" quartz lodes (they being contiguous) and the "Eagles" lode in the same group and adjoining said claims, on the North East side, expenditure and labor being for the development of all three claims jointly, said claims being recorded at Stevenson County seat of Kamania County being recorded in book "D" Miscellaneous, the latter claim in book "B" Miscellaneous. Situated in Bald Mountain Mining District Kamania County State of Washington during the year ending December 31st 1897. Such expenditure was made by or at the expense of A. P. White, Douglas Explorer E. M. Cox, J. L. E. Brown owners of said claims and the purchase of holding said claims. Said work consisted of thirty feet of tunnel on the "Blue Jacket" lode by first going back out on "Hickapoo" and ninety days labor on trail and cabin all for benefit of entire group.
