

# Notice of Location "Chloride" Lode Mining Claim

## Notice of Location "Chloride" Lode Mining Claim.

Copper Creek Mining District.  
Skamania County, State of Washington.

The undersigned, who is a citizen of the United States, hereby declare and give notice to all persons concerned, that he has discovered a Vein or Lode within the limits of the claim hereby located, and in said lode a vein or crevice of quartz or ore, with at least one well-defined wall, and that he has this Seventh day of February A. D. 1899, located and do hereby locate and claim, under and by virtue of Chapter Cix, Title Thirty-two, of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and the laws amendatory thereto, and the laws of the State of Washington, a mining claim upon said Lode or Vein, to be designated and named the Chloride Quartz Lode Mining Claim, extending along said Lode or Vein 1500 feet in a Westerly direction from the center of the Discovery shaft (at which shaft this notice and statement is posted), and 300 feet on each side from the middle or center of said Lode or Vein at the surface; comprising in all 1500 feet in length along said Lode or Vein, and 600 feet in width, with all the rights and privileges, as to surface ground and lodes, veins or ledges, within the boundaries of said Lode and otherwise, and the metals, minerals and valuable deposits of every kind contained in said veins, lodes or ledges, or within said boundaries, which are given or allowed by the laws of the United States aforesaid, or of the State of Washington.

The Mining Claim hereby located is situated in Copper Creek Mining District Skamania County, Washington, and is situated and lying West of Arasta Creek near the E. W. line of J. S. & H. S. Hill. Skamania Co. Wn.

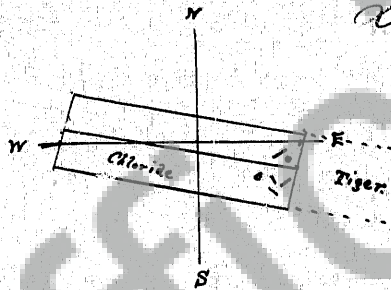

Beginning at this notice and running thence Northerly 300 feet to post marked North East cor. of Chloride claim: Thence Westerly 1500 ft. to post marked North West Cor. of Chloride Claim: Thence Southerly 300 ft. to post marked West Center End post of Chloride

claim: Thence 300 ft. Southerly to post marked South West cor. of Chloride claim: Thence Easterly 1500 ft. to post marked South East cor. of Chloride claim: Thence Northerly 300 ft. to place of beginning, or to where this notice is posted.
