NOTICE OF LIEN

Notice is hereby given that E. Haussman, of Skamania County, Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of timber, lumber and railroad ties, being about 60,000 feet in quantity which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, are unmarked, and are now situated and lying at and upon the platform and in a railroad car of the U P system #25270 at what is known as Dopps Spur about three fourths of a mile East of Skamania Post Office in Skamania County, State of Washington, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in and about cutting, hauling and preparing said timbers, lumber and railway ties for market; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is W.T.Noel and J.P.Noel and W.R. Bailey, doing business under the firm name and style of Noel-Bailey Lumber Company and Hill Lumber Company a corporation; that J.P.Noel employed said E.Haussman to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit: The said J.P.Noel agreed to pay the said E. Haussman for such labor and assistance \$4.50 and \$5.00 per day as a timber faller and hook tender; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said E. Haussman, who performed labor upon and assisted in and about cutting, hauling and preparing said lumber, timber and ties for market for the period during November, 1917, that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said lumber timbers and railroad ties between the 1st day of November, 1917, and the 10th day of November, 1917; and the rendition of said services closed on the 10th day of November, 1917, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that no part thereof has been paid and there is now due and owing this claimant thereon, after deducting all just credit and offsets the sum of \$21.30 in which amount he claims a lien upon all said timbers, ties and lumber. The said E.Haussman also claims a lien on all said ties, timbers, sawlogs, lumber and timber products now owned by said owners above named of said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining said logs, lumber, timbers and timber products.
