NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Ray Bennett, of Skamania County, Washington, claims a lien upon the franchise, earning and all the real and personal property of the Hill Lumber Company and Noel-Bailey Lumber Company, a corporation which was and is used in the operation of the saw mill of said owners to the full extent of all moneys due him for the work and labor for said owner performed within six months next preceding the filing of this claim in the operation of said mill; this demand for said labor is \$56.20, after deducting all just credits and offsets; the name of the persons, firm and corporation owning said mill and mill property is W.T.Noel, J.P.Noel and W.R.Bailey, doing business under the firm and style of Noel-Bailey Lumber Company and Hill Lumber Company, a corporation, the name of the person employing this claimant is J.P.Noel; the terms and conditions of claimant's contract was that claimant was employed to work in said mill as mill engineer at the agreed wage of \$4.00 per day; that claimant began said employment on the 19th day of September, 1917, and the date of his last service was November 10, 1917, that the real and personal property, franchise and earnings which this lien covers is the sawmill known as the Hill Lumber Company or Clark & Stone saw mill situated about 2½ miles northeast of Skamania Post Office and the flume leading therefrom to Dopp's Spur on the S.P. & S. track about ¾ of a mile East of Skamania Post Office all in Skamania County, State of Washington, including all tools, boilers, engines, equipments, lumber, timbers, ties, wood, fixtures and furniture used in and about or in connection with said sawmill and sawmill business.
