NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that J.R. Kee, of Stevenson, Washington, claims a lien upon the franchise, earnings and upon the real and personal property of the owners above named, to-wit: W.T.Noel, J.P.Noel and W.R.Bailey, doing business under the firm name and style of Noel-Bailey Lumber Company, and Hill Lumber Company, a corporation, which franchise, earnings, real and personal property which was and is used in the operation of the saw mill of the said owners to the full extent of all moneys due him from said owners, for labor performed within six months next preceding the filing of this claim therefor, as follows: The demand which is made by the said J.R.Kee from said owners is for the sum of \$138.00, after deducting all just credits and offsets. the name of the person employing this claimant is J.P.Noel, who in so employing him acted for and on behalf of said owners. and the terms and conditions of the said employment were that the said J.R.Kee was to perform work, labor and services for the above named owners in the operation of their saw mill situated on the land hereinafter described as a sawyer at six dollars per day for a ten hour day. That claimant began work as aforesaid on September 4th 1917, and the date of the cessation of his services was November 10th 1917. That the agreed wage of the said claimant for said work was \$6.00 per day; that said claim is made for said sum for work done between September 4th 1917 and November 5th 1917 inclusive. The property on which this lien is filed and the franchise and earning thereof and all the real and personal property of said owners upon which this lien is filed is situated in Skamania County, Washington, and this claim is filed for security for the work above referred to and covers the saw mill known as the Hill Lumber Company or Clark and Stone Mill situate about two and one half miles Northeasterly from Skamania Post Office in Skamania County, Washington, the machinery, tools and appurtenances therein or adjoining and used in connection therewith, the flume extending from said mill to the platform at Dopp's Spur located about 3/4 mile East of Skamania Post Office on the S.P. and S. Railroad, together with all lumber ties and wood, located and being at said mill and at a on the platform at said Dopp's Spur, and on all the earnings and other real and personal property of said owners which was used in the operation of said mill and business during the period of employment of said claimant for which claim is hereby filed, to the full extent of the said sum of \$138.00 which is due him from said owners.
