NOTICE is hereby given that H.A.Strange of Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of lumber, ties and timbers located and being upon the platform and in a Union Pacific System Railroad car Number 25270 at what is known as Dopp's Spur, on the S.P. and S. Railroad, about 3/4 mile East of Skamania, in Skamania County, Washington, being about 60,000 feet in quantity, which were cut and manufactured in Skamania County, Washington, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in and about the cutting, hauling, and preparing said timber, lumber and ties for market; that the names of the owners, or reputed owners are W.T.Noel, J.P.Noel and W. R. Bailey, who are doing business under the firm name and style of Noel-Bailey Lumber Company, and the Hill Lumber Company, a corporation, that said J.P.Noel employed said H.A.Strange for and on behalf of the said above named owners, to perform said labor and to render such assistance, upon the following terms and conditions towit: That the said J.P.Noel for and on behalf of said owners agreed to pay to the said H.A. Strange, for such labor and assistance, the sum of \$4.00 per day for a ten hour day, as a donkey engineer, That said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said H.A.Strange, who performed labor upon and assisted in and about the cutting, hauling and preparing said timber, lumber and ties for market, for the period from October 1, 1917 to and including the 10th of November, 1917, and the rendition of said services closed on the 10th of November, 1917, and thirty days have not elapsed since that date, and that there is now due and owing from said owners to this claimant thereon the sum of \$44.25 after deducting all just credits and offsets., in which amount he claims a lien upon all the lumber timber, and ties aforesaid. The said H.A.Strange also claims a lien upon all the lumber, timber ties and logs, and on all timber products now owned by said owners, above named, in said Skamania County, to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining said logs, lumber, ties, timber and timber products.
