

Wm. DONOVAN vs W.T. NOEL et al

Wm. Donovan, Claimant

W.T.Noel, J.P.Noel and W. R. Bailey, doing business under the firm and style of Noel-Bailey Lumber Co., and Hill Lumber Company, a corporation.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wm Donovan, of Skamania County, Washington, claims a lien upon the franchise, earnings and all the real and personal property of the owners above named, to wit: the said Noel-Bailey Lumber Company and the Hill Lumber Company, a corporation, which franchise, earnings and real and personal property was and is used in the operation of the saw mill of said owners, to the full extent all moneys due him from said owners for labor performed within six months next preceding the filing of this claim therefor, as follows: The demand which is made by the said Wm Donovan from the said owners is for the sum of \$50.30, after deducting all just credits and offsets. The names of the persons employing said claimant, and who acted for and on behalf of said owners is J.P.Noel and the terms and conditions of said employment were that the claimant was to perform work, labor and services for the above named company and owners in the operation of their sawmill situated on the land hereinafter described as a night watchman; that claimant began work aforesaid on October 19, 1917, for said owners and the date of the cessation of said services was November 10, 1917, that the agreed wage of said claimant for said work was \$3.00 per day; that said claim is for work done during the months of October and November, 1917; that the property upon which this lien is filed and the franchises and earnings thereof and all the real and personal property of said owners upon which this lien is filed is situated in Skamania County, Washington, and this claim is filed for security for the work above referred to and covers the sawmill known as the Hill Lumber Company or Clark & Stone saw mill situated about two and one half miles north-easterly from the Post Office at Skamania, Skamania County, State of Washington, the machinery, tools and appurtenances therein or adjoining and used in connection therewith, the flume extending from said saw mill to the platform at Dopp's Spur located 3/4 of a mile East of the Skamania Postoffice aforesaid, on the S.P. & S. Ry. together with all lumber, ties, and wood located at said mill and at said Dopp's Spur and on all the earnings and on all the other real and personal property of said owners which was used in the operation of said sawmill and business during the period of the employment of said claimant for which claim is hereby filed to the full extent of said sum of \$50.30, which is due him from said owners.
