NOTICE OF LIEN

W.T. Noel, J.P. Noel and W.R. Bailey,
doing business under the firm name
and style of Noel-Bailey Lumber Co.,
and Hill Lumber Company, a corporation,

Notice is hereby given that Wm. F. Broscheit of Skamania County, Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of lumber, ties and timbers located and being upon the platform at Dopp's Spur about 3/4 of a mile East of Skamania Post Office on the Spokane Portland & Seattle Company's Railway, amounting to about \$30,000 feet; also approximately 739 railroad ties now being and contained in a certain car of the Union Pacific System No. 25270 standing on the track at said Dopp's Spur which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, and which are unmarked; for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in and about cutting, hauling and preparing said lumber and timber products for market as a timber faller; that the names of the owners or reputed owners of said lumber timber and railroad ties are W.T. Noel, J.P. Noel, W.R. Bailey and Hill Lumber Company, a corporation; that J.P. Noel, for and on behalf, of the above named owners employed the said Wm. F. Broscheit to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit: the said owners agreed to pay the said Wm. F. Broscheit the sum of \$4.75 per day for labor as such timber faller; that such contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said claimant who performed such labor and rendered such assistance for the period between October 22, 1917, and the 10th day of November, 1917, and the rendition of such services was closed on the 10th day of November, 1917, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said services is \$29.90; that no part of said claim has been paid and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon the sum of \$29.90 after deducting all just credits and offsets, in which amount he claims a lien upon the timber products above described. That said Wm. F. Broscheit also claims a lien upon all lumber, ties, timber and timber products now owned by said Noel-Bailey Lumber Co and Hill Lumber Company, a corporation to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, ties, timber, lumber or other timber products.
