NOTICE OF LIEN

W.T.Noel, J.P.Noel, W.R.Bailey, doing
business under the firm name and style
of Noel-Bailey Lumber Company, and
Hill Lumber Company, Owners.

Notice is hereby given that Henry Houseman of Skamania, Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of lumber, ties and timbers, located and being at and upon the platform and in a Union Pacific System railroad car numbered 25270 at what is known as Popp's Spur, about 3/4 miles East of Skamania in Skamania County, Washington, being about 60,000 feet in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, Washington, for labor performed upon and for assistance rendered in and about the cutting, hauling and preparing said timber, lumber and ties for market; that the names of the owners or reputed owners are W.T.Noel, J.P.Noel and W.R.Bailey, doing business under the firm name and style of Noel-Bailey Lumber Company and Hill Lumber Company, a corporation; that said J.P.Noel, for and on behalf of the said owners, employed the said Henry Houseman to perform said labor and to render said assistance, upon the following terms and conditions to-wit: the said J.P.Noel, for and on behalf of the said owners, agreed to pay the said Henry Houseman, for such labor and assistance, the sum of \$4.25 and \$4.50 per day for a ten hour day, as a timber faller and rigging man, That said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said Henry Houseman, who performed labor upon and assisted in and about the cutting, hauling and preparing said timber, lumber, ties and logs for market, from August 15th 1917 to the 10th day of November 1917, and the rendition of said services ended on the 10th of November, 1917, and thirty days have not elapsed since that date. That there is now due and owing to this claimant, thereon the sum of \$114.00 after deducting all just credits and offsets. In which amount he claims a lien upon all the timber, lumber and ties aforesaid. The said Henry Houseman also claims a lien upon all the logs, lumber, timber and ties now owned by the said owners, above named, in said Skamania County, Washington, to secure payment for the work and labor aforesaid performed in obtaining said lumber, timber and ties.
