NOTICE OF LIEN.

W.T. Noel, J.P. Noel and W.R.Bailey, doing business under the firm name and style of Noel-Bailey Lumber Co., and Hill Lumber Company, a corporation;

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Harry. Randelle of Skamania County, Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of lumber, railroad ties and timbers located and being upon the platform at Dopp's Spur about 3/4 of a mile East of the Skamania Post Office in Skamania County, Washington, on the S.P. & S. Railway amounting to about 30,000 feet, also approximately 739 fir railroad ties now contained in a certain box car belonging to the U.P. system being Car No.25270 standing on the railway track at said Dopp's Spur, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, and which are unmarked, for labor upon and assistance rendered in and about cutting, hauling and preparing said timber products for market as a cook; that the names of the owners, or reputed owners, of said timbers, lumber and railroad ties are W.T.Noel, J.P. Noel, W.R.Bailey and Hill Lumber Company, a corporation, that J.P.Noel employed the said Harry Rundelle to perform such labor and render such assistance on the following terms and conditions, to wit; the said owners employed this claimant as such cook to assist in getting out, cutting, hauling and obtaining such timber products for market at the agreed wage of \$80.00 per month; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of this claimant, who performed such labor and rendered such assistance for the period between November 1, 1917, and November 10, 1917 inclusive, and the rendition of such services was closed on the 10th day of November, 1917, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for such services is \$28.00; that no part of said claim has been paid and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon the sum of \$28.00, after deducting all just credits and offsets, in which amount he claims a lien upon the timber products above described. The said Harry Rundelle also claims a lien upon all lumber, timber, ties and timber products of the said owners in Skamania County, Washington, to secure the payment for the work and labor performed in securing the said ties, timber, lumber and timber products.
