## NOTICE OF LIEN

W.T. Noel, J.P.Noel and W.R.Bailey doing business under the firm name and style of Noel-Bailey Lumber Co., and Hill Lumber Company, a corporation,

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Omar McBroom, of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of lumber, railroad ties and timbers located and being upon the platform at Dopp's Spur about 3/4 of a mile East of Skamania post office in Skamania County, Washington, on the S.P. & S railway amounting to about 30,000 feet, also approximately 739 fir railroad ties now being in and contained in a certain car belonging to the Union Pacific System No.25270 standing on the railway track at said Dopp's Spur, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, and which are unmarked, for labor upon and assistance rendered in and about cutting, hauling obtaining and preparing said timbers, lumber and railroad ties for market, as a timber faller; that the names of the owners, or reputed owners, of said timbers, lumber and railroad ties are W.T.Noel, J.P.Noel, W.R.Bailey and Hill Lumber Company, a corporation; that J.P.Noel, for and on behalf of the above named owners employed the said Omar McBroom to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit: the said owners employed this claimant as such timber faller to assist in getting out, cutting hauling and obtaining such timber products for market at the agreed wage of \$4.50 per day; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said claimant who performed such labor and rendered such assistance from the period of November 6th 1917 to November 10, 1917, inclusive and the rendition of such services was closed on the 10th day of November, 1917, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for such services is \$15.75; that no part of said claim has been paid and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon the sum of \$15.75, after deducting all just credits and offsets, in which amount he claims a lien upon the timber products above described. The said claimant also claims a lien upon all lumber, ties, timber and timber products now owned by said above named owner in said county to secure the payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said ties, timber, lumber or timber products.
