## NOTICE OF LIEN

W.T.Noel, J.P.Noel, W.R.Bailey, doing business under the firm name and style of Noel-Bailey Lumber Company and Hill Lumber Company, a corporation

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that W.M.Lattin of Skamania County, Washington has and claims a lien upon the franchise, earnings and all the real and personal property of the owners above named, towit: the said Noel-Bailey Lumber Company and Hill Lumber Company, a corporation, which franchise, earnings and real and personal property was and is used in the operation of the sawmill of said owners to the full extent of all moneys due him from said owners for labor performed within six months next preceding the filing of this claim therefor, as follows: The demand which is made by the said W.M.Lattin from said owners is for the sum of \$15.00 after deducting all just credits and offsets; the name of the person employing the said claimant and who acted for and on behalf of the said owners is J.P.Noel, and the terms and conditions of the said employment are that the claimant W.M.Lattin was to perform work, labor and services for the above named company and corporation and owners in the operation of their saw mill situated on the land hereinafter described as a trim sawyer in said mill; that claimant began said work on the 23d day of October, 1917, and the date of the cessation of said services was November 10th, 1917; that the agreed wage of said claimant for said work was \$4.00 per day of ten hours; that this claim is made for work done during the months of October and November, 1917; The property on which this lien is filed is situated in Skamania County, Washington, and this claim is filed for security for the work above referred to and covers the saw mill known as the Hill Lumber Company or Clark & Stone Mill situated about two and one half miles Northeasterly from Skamania Post office in said county and State, the machinery, tools and appurtenances therein and adjoining and used in connection therewith, the flume extending from said mill to the platform at Dopp's Spur located about 3/4 of a mile East of Skamania Post office on the S P & S railway together with all lumber, ties and wood located at said mill and at said Dopp's Spur and all the earnings and all the other real and personal property of said owners which was used in the operation of said mill and business during the time of the employment of said claimant for which claim is hereby filed to the full extent of said sum of \$15.00 which is due to him from said owners.
