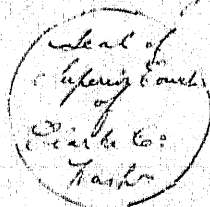

Be it remembered, That on the 27th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Eighty nine, Edward R. Kinville, late of France, in the French Republic at present of Skamania County, in the State of Washington, appeared in the Superior Court of the aforesaid County and State, (the said Court being a Court of Record, having Common-law Jurisdiction, a Clerk and Seal,) and applied to the said Court to be admitted to become a Citizen of the United States of America, pursuant to the direction and requisition of the several Acts of Congress in relation thereto; and the said Edward R. Kinville, having thereupon produced to the Court such evidence of his former good conduct, of his being attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and of his residence within the limits and jurisdiction of the said United States for the space of - 5 - years last past, and for the last year within Washington Territory and State and made such declarations and renunciations, and taken such oaths as are by the said Acts required; thereupon it was ordered by the said Court that the said Edward R. Kinville be admitted, and he is accordingly, admitted by the said Court to be a Citizen of the United States of America.
