

Notice of Location "Golden Rod" Mining Claim.

Notice of Location of Quartz Claim.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned a citizen of the United States over the age of twenty-one years, on the 28th day of April 1899 discovered a vein or lode of quartz or sand rock in place bearing gold, within the limits of the claim hereby located and have this 28th day of April 1899, under and in accordance with the Revised Statutes of the United States, located fifteen hundred linear feet of this vein or lode in length, with surface ground, three hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said lode, together with all dips, spurs and angles and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lies within said boundaries, situated in the Bald Mountain Mining district, County of Skamania State of Washington, and known as the Golden Rod claim and extending 1500 feet in a north-westerly course from this notice or the north end of the Cold Hill Mining Claim. The exterior boundaries of this claim being marked by references to natural objects, or permanent monuments and more particularly described as follows to wit; commencing at a point on the section line between Sections 12 and 13 Town 3 North, Range 5 East T. 3 N. 400 feet West of the quarter stake thence from said point in a northwesterly direction 500 feet to South End center post of the Golden Rod claim thence 1500 feet in a northwesterly direction where the North end center post is set. At the South Corner post one witness tree yellow fir two feet in diameter direction North West 36 inches from corner stake one witness tree Hemlock 6 inches in diameter direction from corner stake 20 degrees West of South West and 22 inches from stake. The East corner post one witness tree one yellow fir tree about 3 feet in diameter direction from stake South West 21 feet 6 inches from stake one witness tree a Hemlock 12 inches in diameter direction from stake 20 degrees East of North distance 11 feet and 2 inches.

The Golden Rod Claim is located in the South West quarter of section twelve (12) Town 3 North Range 5 East T. 3 N. and joins the North End of the Cold Hill Mining Claim and I intend to hold and work said above described claim as provided by State law

Notice of Location of "Gold Hill" Mining Claim.

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Situated in the Bald Mountain Mining District, County of Okanogan and State of Washington, and known as the Gold Hill Mining Claim, and extending sixty feet Northwesterly from this notice or prospect shaft or point of discovery, to North end center line stake and fourteen hundred and forty feet in a South Easterly direction to connect with the North End of the Gold Standard Claim.

The exterior boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point on the section line four hundred feet West of quarter stake between sections 12 and 13 Town 9 North, Range five (5) East W.M. from said point in Northwesterly direction (580) five hundred and eighty feet to the North end center post, thence back to point of beginning. Hence on
