 Application 5485 } has been deposited
 in the general Land Office of the United States
 a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office
 at Vancouver Washington Territory whereby
 it appears that pursuant to the act of Congress
 approved 20th May, 1862, to Secure Homesteads
 to actual Settlers on the Public domain and the
 acts supplemental thereto the claim of Jackson
 V Means has been established and duly consum-
 mated in conformity to law for the South East
 quarter of Section thirty two in township two
 North of Range six east of Willamette Meridian
 in Washington Territory containing one hundred
 and sixty acres according to the Official Plat
 of the Survey of the said Land returned to the General
 Land Office by the Surveyor General; Now Know
 ye that there is therefore granted by the United
 States unto the said Jackson V Means the tract
 of land above described; To have and to Hold the
 said tract of land with the appurtenances thereof
 unto the said Jackson V Means and to his heirs
 and assigns forever; subject to any vested and
 accrued water rights for mining agricultural
 manufacturing or other purposes and rights
 to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with
