M.H.Benson, Claimant

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that M.H.Benson of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of four foot and sixteen inch fir cordwood, being about 130 cords in quantity which was cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, is unmarked, and is now lying on the Charles Olien land about  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile westward from the town of Stevenson in said county, such tract containing about 33 acres in Section 2, Township 2, North of Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian, and piled on the railroad track about 150 yards east, of the depot in Stevenson, said County, for labor performed and assistance rendered in and about hauling said cordwood; that the name of the owner, or reputed owner, is F.H.Hapgood and Smythe & Lonergan; that F.H.Hapgood employed the said M.H.Benson to perform such labor and render such assistance on the following terms and conditions, to-wit: the said F.H.Hapgood agreed to pay the said M.H.Benson the sum of \$1.00 per cord for hauling said wood; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said M.H.Benson who performed labor and rendered assistance in and about hauling said cordwood for the period between Sept. 20th, 1917, and the 28th day of November, 1917, and the rendition of said services closed on the 27th day of November, 1917, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said services is \$144.50; that no part thereof has been paid and there is now due and owing and remaininf unpaid thereon the sum of \$144.00 in which amount he claims a lien upon said cordwood. The said M.H.Benson also claims a lien upon all the wood of said owners in said county to secure the payment for the labor in securing said cordwood.
