

This Indenture Witnesseth, that I John Harrington of the County of Clarke in the Territory of Washington in Consideration of Seven Hundred Dollars, to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto Alonzo Knight the following described premises, to wit: The West half of the south West Quarter of Section thirty (30) in Township two (2) North of Range five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian, Containing Eighty one (81) Acres and fourteen hundredths of an acre. Situated in Skamania County Washington Territory. Together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining. To Have and to hold the same with the appurtenances unto the said Alonzo Knight his heirs and assigns forever.

This Conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars, and the interest thereon, in accordance with the tenor of a certain promissory note, of which the following is a copy, to wit:

 Five years after date for value received I promise to pay to the order of Alonzo D. Knight Seven Hundred Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of ten per Cent. per Annum for first three years and eight per Cent. per Annum thereafter interest payable annually. If the interest is not paid when due, it shall be compounded with the principal and bear like interest therewith.

Principal and interest payable in U. S. Gold Coins and in case suit is instituted to collect this note or any portion thereof I promise to pay such additional sum as the Court may adjudge reasonable as attorney's fees, to be taxed as a part of the costs of such suit, for the use of Plaintiff's Attorney.
