

TAYLOR to CORNWELL.

NOTICE OF LIEN

Dan Cornwell, Claimant

vs

W.H. Taylor.

Notice is hereby given that Dan Cornwell of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of four foot fir cordwood, being about twenty (20) cords in quantity, which was cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, are unmarked, and are now lying and situated as follows; about $17\frac{1}{2}$ cords being ricked and piled on Section 27 Township 3 North of Range 8 east of the Willamette Meridian in the woods where cut about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile north of the S P & S depot at Home Valley in said County and $2\frac{1}{2}$ cords lying at the railroad station at Home Valley station in said county, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in and about cutting, splitting and preparing said cordwood for market; that the name of the owner or reputed owner of said cordwood is W.H. Taylor; that said W.H. Taylor employed said Dan Cornwell to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit:

The said W.H. Taylor agreed to pay the said Dan Cornwell for such labor and assistance the sum of \$2.00 per cord for cutting, splitting and preparing said cordwood for market; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Dan Cornwell, who performed labor upon and assisted in cutting, sawing, piling and preparing said cordwood for market for a period of about 15 days; that said labor and assistance was so performed and rendered upon said cordwood between the 9th day of April, 1918, and the 21st day of May, 1918; and the rendition of said services was closed on the 20th day of May, 1918, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for service is \$40.00; that no part thereof has been paid, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$40.00 in which amount he claims a lien upon said cordwood. The said Dan Cornwell also claims a lien on all said cordwood now owned by said W.H. Taylor of said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said cordwood, herein described.
