NOTICE OF LIEN.

K.A. Thompson & C.V. Thompson Claimant, vs. Al Iman, Geo Iman & C. Fields. Notice is hereby given that K.A. Thompson & C.V. Thompson of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of ties, being about 875 in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, are marked thus... and are now lying at spur S.P.&S Ry. at Prindle, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in hauling said ties; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is Al Iman, Geo. Iman & C. Fields; That Al Iman, Geo Iman & Fields employed said K.A. Thompson & C.V. Thompson to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:-

That said Al Iman, Geo. Iman, & C. Fields agreed to pay the said K.A. Thompson & C.V. Thompson for such labor and assistance \$4.00 per M; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said K.A. Thompson & C.V. Thompson, who performed labor upon and assisted in hauling said ties for the period of -----; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said ties between the 2nd day of June, 1918 and the 29th day of June, and the rendition of said service was closed on the 28th day of June, 1918, and thirty ^{not} days have elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$176.21; that no part thereof has been paid except \$36.42; and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting and just credits and offsets, the sum of \$139.79, in which amount he claims and lien upon said ties. The said K.A. Thompson & C.V. Thompson also claims a lien on said ties now owned by said Al Iman, Geo. Iman & C. Fields of said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, spars, piles or other timber, lumber or shingles herein described.
