

This Indenture, Made the 5th day of
 June in the Year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and eighty nine between
 Alex. Deio and John Deio residing at
 Dallas City, County of Harris State of Oregon
 the parties of the first part and John Dorman
 residing at Dallas City Co. of Harris State
 of Oregon, the party of the second part,
 Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first
 part for and in consideration of the sum of One
 thousand two hundred dollars of the United
 States, to us in hand paid by the said party of
 the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, assigned
 transferred and set over, and by these presents do
 grant bargain and sell, assign transfer and set
 over, unto the said party of the second part, all
 those certain goods and Chattle now being in our
 possession at Harris County State of Oregon, and
 described as follows to wit: The Bangor Wood
 boat known as the Bang "Julia" being the
 same boat or barge this day sold by the said
 John Dorman to Alex. Deio and John Deio -
 To have and to hold, all and singular the said
 goods and Chattle above bargained and sold, or
 intended to be unto the said party of the second
 part his, executors, Administrators and assigns
 forever. Provided nevertheless, and these presents are
 upon this express Condition that if the said parties
 of the first part their executors, administrators or
 Assigns shall will and truly pay unto the said
 party of the second part his executor, administrator
 or assigns, the sum of One thousand two hundred
 Dollars and interest. In accordance with the
 terms of 30 promissory notes payable as follows
 to wit: No 1. for \$40.00 Payable 1 day after date 10% int June ^{paid} 1889.
 No. 2 for \$40.00 Payable July 1st 1889 10% int. Paid June 1889
 No. 3 Date June 1st 1889 \$40.00 Payable Aug 1/89 10% int.
 No. 4 " " 5th 40. " " Sep 1/89 10% "
