

"Pacific" Mining Claim, Bald Mountain District.

Notice of Location.

To whom it may concern:

Notice is hereby given, That J. Robt. A. Hill a citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did on the First day of January A.D. 1898, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate a Mining Claim, known as the Pacific Quartz Lode or Mining Claim, said claim having been discovered the First day of January 1898, and do claim fifteen hundred linear feet on this lode, lode a vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries situated in Bald Mtn Mining District County of Okanogan State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Located on Blue Jacket Creek a tributary of the Blue Bird Creek. This claim is located at foot of Falls on Blue Jacket Creek Falls 14 feet high 30 feet above Falls about 30 feet high. Commencing discovery at Post No. 1. Thence 300 feet in an North Easterly direction to Corner Post No. 2. Thence 1500 feet North Westerly direction to corner Post No. 3. Thence 300 feet in a South Westerly direction to center Post No. 4. Thence 300 feet same direction to corner Post No. 5. Thence 1500 feet Southeasterly direction to corner Post No. 6. Thence 300 feet North Easterly direction to place of beginning.

Bound on the West by the Kikapoo Mining claim and I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the Mining Laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
