

IMAN ET-AL to THOMPSON (FOR THOMPSON A MINOR.)

G.R. Thompson for Russell Thompson a minor Claimant, vs Al. Iman, Geo. Iman & C. Fields
NOTICE is hereby given that G.R. Thompson for Russell Thompson a minor of Skamania County
State of Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of ties, being about 875 in quantity,
which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County State of Washington, are marked thus....
..... and are now lying at spur of S.R. & S. Ry. at Pribble, for labor performed and assistance rendered in Manufacturing said ties; that the name of the owner or reputed owners Al. Iman, Geo. Iman, & C. Fields, that they employed said Russell Thompson, minor to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

That said Al. Iman, Geo. Iman, C. Fields agreed to pay the said Russell Thompson for such labor and assistance \$3.60 per day; with that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Russell Thompson, who performed labor upon and assisted in Manufacturing said ties for the period of 21 days 6 hours; that said ties between the 27th day of May, 1918 and the 29th day of June, 1918, and the rendition of said service was closed of the 28th day of June, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$77.62; that no part thereof has been paid except \$15.75 board and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and c. ets, the sum of \$61.87, in which amount the a lien upon said ties. The said Russell Thompson also claims a lien on said ties now owned by said Al. Iman, Geo. Iman, C. Fields of said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, spars, piles or other timber, lumber or shingles herein described.
