

This Indenture Made, the 5th day of June, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty nine between P. L. Moore residing at County of Wasco, State of Oregon, the party of the first part, and John D. Moran residing at Dallas City County of Wasco, State of Oregon, the party of the second part. Witness: That the said party of the first part for certain Consideration that the party of the first part has this day sold to the party of the second part 100 cords of four foot fir wood to be delivered on the bank of the Columbia river on or before the 1st day of March 1890. have granted, bargained, sold, assigned, transferred and set over, and by these presents does grant bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the said party of the second part, all those Certain goods and Chattle now being in my possession at Skamania County Washington Territory, and described as follows, to wit: One bay horse about 9 years old about 15 1/2 hands high named Bill Branded W. on left shoulder. One sorrel horse about 9 years old about 15 1/2 hands high named Chaney Branded W. on left shoulder. One two horse Wagon. One Double set of harness.

Whereas the party of the first part is to deliver to the party of the second part one hundred Cords of fir wood said Wood to be delivered on the bank of the Columbia river at a point where the same can be conveniently loaded on to a barge for transportation to Dallas City Oregon, on or before March 1st 1890. It is hereby expressly agreed by and between the parties hereto that this Mortgage shall be held by the party of the second part for the faithful performance of the first party in delivering said wood. Do Here and to hold all and singular the said goods and Chattle above bargained and sold, or intended so to be, unto the said party of the second part his executors administrators and assigns forever.
