

HOOD LUMBER Company. TO DARR:

NOTICE of lien.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that W.F.Darr, of Skamania County, State of Washington hereby claims a lien upon all the logs, lumber, railroad ties, and timber products of whatsoever kind or nature, together with the mill and all mill machinery, logging outfit, and all personal property of whatsoever kind or nature belonging to or in the possession of the MOUNT HOOD LUMBER COMPANY, a corporation, operating and doing a sawmill and lumber business at or near Skamania, Skamania County, State of Washington, such lumber as is lying at the mill of said corporation and at Dopp's Spur on the B.P.&S. Railway, either loaded or unloaded.

Said Lien is claimed for stumpage for and on account of the claimant having permitted the said MOUNT HOOD LUMBER COMPANY to cut timber for such lumber and logs on the following described lands, said County to-wit:-

The East Half of the West half of Section 23; the North half of the southeast quarter of Section 23 and the Northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 24 and the south half of the southeast quarter of Section 23 and the South half of the Southwest quarter of Section 24, all in Township 2 North of Range 6 East of the Willamette Meridian.

That the agreed price for said timber is \$1.00 per thousand feet for a part thereof and \$1.50 per thousand feet for a part thereof and that the whole sum claimed as such stumpage lien is \$960.67. That said sum is actually due claimant for such stumpage from said Mount Hood Lumber Company, over and above all just claims and off-sets. That the taking of said timber has not yet ceased, but the said sum is the amount due at this date, which the said Mount Hood Lumber Company, fails and neglects to pay.
