

AL IMAN, GEO. IMAN AND C. C. FIELDS to ALBERT ZINIKER
LIEN NOTICE.

Notice is hereby given that Albert Ziniker and John Ziniker, of Skamania County, Washington, claim a lien upon a certain quantity of ties, lumber and logs being about 875 ties, and being piled at the Spur of the S. P. & S. Ry, at Prindle, Skamania County, Washington, and the said lumber being about 7 thousand feet in quantity piled at the mill of the above named owners on the "J. T. Haffey place" in Skamania County, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in manufacturing said ties and lumber; that the names of the owners or reputed owners are Al Iman, Geo. Iman, and C. C. Fields, and that they employed the said Albert Ziniker, the minor son of the said John Ziniker, upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

That the said Al Iman, Geo. Iman and C. C. Fields agreed to pay the said Albert Ziniker for such services the sum of \$4.50 per day; that said contract has been faithfully performed and complied with on the part of the said claimant Albert Ziniker, who performed labor upon and assisted in the manufacture of said ties and timber for the period of 12 days between the 31st day of May, 1918, and the 20th day of June, 1918, and the rendition of said services were closed on the said 20th day of June, 1918, and that thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants' demand for said services is the sum of \$54.00 and that no part thereof has been paid except the sum of \$4.20 and that there is now due claimants the sum of \$49.80 after deducting all just credits and offsets, in which amount claimants claim a lien upon said ties and lumber; that the said claimants also claim a lien upon all ties and lumber now owned by the said Al Iman, Geo. Iman and C. C. Fields in said Skamania County to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said ties and lumber herein described.
