NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that... J. Hammon..... of Stevenson, Skamania County Washington claims a lien on the franchise, earnings, and on all the real and personal property owned and used in the operation of the Mt Hood Lumber Company and J.L. Weist and John Doe Vanderberg's and L.C. Stone's mill, particularly located and described as follows:

On said sawmill and all the equipment, tools, lumber, machinery, belts, pulleys and ~~and~~ buildings and on all the lumber around and about said mill belonging to the said Mt Hood Lumber Company and J.L. Weist and L.C. Stone & John Doe Vanderberg, said mill being located on leased land in the southeast quarter of section 23, Township 2 North Range 6 East, Willamette Meridian; also on one certain lot of lumber, consisting of about 30,000 feet of mixed lumber, and a lumber dock, located in the southwest quarter of Section 24, Township 2 North Range 6 East of the Willamette Meridian. Also on one certain steam logging donkey engine, together with the lines, chockers and hooks, blocks, and all other logging equipment and apparatus belonging thereto and situated on and about the above described premises. And also on one and one-half miles offlume situated on the aforesaid described premises, and also on one gasoline drag saw and equipment situated on the aforesaid described premises.

The name of the owners or reputed owners of the above described property is the Mt Hood Lumber Company and L.C. Stone & J.L. Weist and John Doe Vanderberg, whose principal place of business is Skamania, Skamania County, State of Washington, and that this claimant was employed by said Mt Hood Lumber Company and L.C. Stone & J.L. Weist and John Doe Vanderberg, at the request of J.L. Weist, agent for the aforesaid parties, upon the following terms and conditions:

That said Mt Hood Lumber Company and J.L. Weist and L.C. Stone and John Doe Vanderberg agreed to pay this claimant H.R. Scribner, the sum of ~~sixty~~... cents per hour for his services as laborer, more particularly described as hired ~~as a choker setter~~ as a choker setter.

The said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of J. Hammon, who performed labor upon and assisted in the handling and securing of logs and the manufacture of lumber in and about the aforesaid parties' mill, for 1284.. hours. That said labor and assistance and services were performed and rendered upon said logs and lumber between the 29th day of June, 1918 and the 19th day of July, 1918, and the rendition of said service was closed on the 19th day of July, 1918, and the amount of claimants demand for said services is \$77.19... That no part thereof has been paid and there is now due and unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits, the sum of \$53.19... in which amount this claimant claims a lien on all of the ~~property~~ above and foregoing described real and personal property or any interest in the Mt Hood Lumber Company or J.L. Weist or L.C. Stone, or John Doe Vanderberg may have in said real and personal property, to secure payment for work and labor and services performed as herein described. Said work and labor having been performed within 90 days last past.
