## NOTICE OF CLAIM OF LIEN FOR LABOR.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Neil M. Black of Stevensen, Skamania County, Washington, claims a lien on the franchise earnings, and on all the real and personal property owned by and used in the operation of the Mt. Hood Lumber Company and J. L. Weist and John Doe Vanderberg's and L. C. Stone's mill, particularly located and described as follows:

On said sawmill and all the equipment, tools, lumber trucks, machinery, belts, pulleys, and buildings and on all the lumber around and about said mill belonging to the said Mt. Hood Lumber Company and J. L. Weist and John Doe Vanderberg, and L. C. Stone, said mill being located on leased land in the southeast quarter of Section 23, Township 2 North Range 6 East, Willamette Meridian; also on one certain lot of lumber, consisting of about 1000 railroad ties, about 15,000 feet of scantling, about 30,000 feet of mixed lumber, and a lumber dock, located in the southwest quarter of Section 24, Township 2 North Range 6 East of the Willamette Meridian. Also on one certain steam logging donkey engine, together with the lines, chokers, hooks, blocks, and all other logging equipment and apparatus belonging thereto and situated on one and one-half miles of flume situated on the aforesaid described premises. And also on one gasoline dragsaw and equipment situated on the aforesaid described premises.

The name of the owners or reputed owners of the above described personal property is the Mt. Hood Lumber Company and L. C. Stone and J. L. Weist and John Doe Vanderberg, whose principal place of business is Skamania, Skamania County, Washington, and that this claimant was employed by said Mt. Hood Lumber Company and L. C. Stone and the said J. L. Weist and John Doe Vanderberg at the request of J. L. Weist, agent for the aforesaid parties, upon the following terms and conditions.

The said Mt. Hood Lumber Company and J. L. Weist and L. C. Stone and John Doe Vanderberg agreed to pay this claimant, Neil M. Black the sum of six and 00/100 (\$6.00) dollars per day for his services as laborer, more particularly described as hired to have charge of the loading dock and to perform work on handling the lumber on said dock.

The said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of Neil M. Black who performed labor upon and assisted in the handling and securing of logs and the manufacture of lumber and the handling of the same in and about the aforesaid parties mill, for \$6.00 per day. That said labor and assistance and services were performed and rendered upon said logs and lumber between the 5th day of July, 1918, and the 20th day of July, 1918. The rendition of said services was closed on the 20th day of July, 1918, and the amount of claimants demand for said services is \$90.00. That no part thereof has been paid except-----, and there is now due and unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits, the sum of \$90.00 in which amount this claimant claims a lien on all of the above and foregoing described real and personal property or any interest in the Mt. Hood Lumber Company or L. C. Stone or J. L. Weist or John Doe Vanderberg may have in said real and personal property to secure payment for work and labor and services performed as herein described. Said work and labor having been performed within 90 days last past.
