

"Patrick" Claim. Bald Mountain Mining District.

Notice of Location.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and the local customs, laws and regulations, has located 1500 linear feet on the Patrick ledge, situated in Bald Mountain Mining District, Okanogan County, State of Washington, and described as follows:

The claim is known as the "Patrick" mine and commences at this post and notice of discovery which is on the Blue Jacket creek about 250 yards up from where said creek flows into the Blue Bird creek and about 500 feet below Blue Jacket mining shaft and tunnel, the center line of said claim runs in a South East course from this post and notice and crosses a draw in about 1125 feet from discovery. Claim 1500 linear feet in a South East coarse from this post and notice of discovery and 300 linear feet on the East side of center line and 250 feet on the West side of center line or joins the Blue Jacket mine, this claim is bounded on the West by the Blue Jacket mine and on the North by the Michel mining claim, includes all dips - spurs and angles inside of said boundary.
