NOTICE OF LIEN.

Notice is hereby given that C. H. Cummings of Skamania County, Washington, claims a lien upon the crop of tomatoes, squash and potatoes being about 11 acres planted, more or less, which were planted on the property of W. H. Galligan said property being described as NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and Lot 1 and Tax Lots 2 & 3 of Sec. 30 Twp/ 3 R/ 10 E. W. M. Said crop was planted by J. C. Clarkson, lessee, and claimant claims a lien upon all of said crop for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in planting, caring for and harvesting said crop; that said Clarkson is the owner or reputed owner of said crop; that he employed said claimant to perform such labor and the following terms and conditions:

The said Clarkson agreed to pay said claimant for such labor and assistance; that said contract has been faithfully performed up to date and fully complied with; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said crops between March 18, 1918, and August 13, 1918; and said claimant expects and intends to continue in such services until said crops are entirely harvested, and forty days have not elapsed since rendition of said services; that the amount of claimant's demand to date is \$382.50 no part of which has been paid and the whole thereof is now due and unpaid and there are no credits of offsets against said claim, and said claimant also claims a lien against all of said crops for the continuance of his services while taking charge of the harvesting, care and attention of said crops to secure payment for such care and attention.
