NOTICE OF LIEN.

Quincy Wade Claimant, vs, Fir Lumber Co.

Notice is hereby given that Quincy Wade of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a lot of lumber, being about 800000 ft. in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County State of Washington, are marked this and are now lying in Yard at Mill of Fir Lumber Co. for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in securing said lumber; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is Fir Lumber Co. that Fir Lumber Co. employed said Quincy Wade to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:-
 and assistance 106.05. that said contract has been faithfully performed
 That said Fir Lumber Co. agreed to pay the said Quincy Wade for such labor performed and fully complied with on the part of said Quincy Wade, who performed labor upon and assisted in securing said lumber for the period of 166 hours; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said lumber between the 30th day of July, 1918, and the 28th day of July, 1918; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 27th day of July, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$80.00, in which amount he claims a lien on all said Lumber. The said Quincy Wade also claims a lien upon said lumber now owned by said Fir Lumber Manufacturing Co. of said County to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, spars, piles or other timber, lumber or shingles herein described.


