

State of Washington to Robert A. Hill.

Permit to Prospect Mineral Lands.

This provisional Lease, License or Permit, made and entered into this 15th day of Sept 1898 by and between the State of Washington and Robert A. Hill of Skye, Wash.,

Witnesseth: That for and in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) paid the Treasurer of the State of Washington, said State of Washington doth license the said Robert A. Hill to prospect that tract or parcel of land now belonging to the said State of Washington and said to contain mineral other than coal (but not known to be mineral bearing at the time of survey), situate in the County of Skamania and more particularly described as follows, viz:

Commencing at the northwest corner of Section 33, Township 3 N. Range 5 E. T. 11. M. Thence south on said section line 600 feet to a larch post. Thence southeasterly 58° 1150 feet to a hemlock post (No. 3) Thence N. 600 ft. to a hemlock post (No. 4) Thence Northwest 58° 1150 ft. to place of beginning, at N. W. corner of Sec. 33.

being state land selected for Pub. Bldgs. at state Capital in the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, Township 3 N., Range 5 E. T. 11. M., containing - acres, the same being in Tall Mt. Mining District.

This provisional Lease being granted under the provision of Chapter CII., Session Laws of 1897, approved March 14, 1897.
