

Notice of Location of "Sweden" Mining Claim

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, a citizen of the United States over the age of twenty-one years on the first day of January 1898 discovered a vein or lode of Quartz or sand rock bearing Gold, Silver or Lead, within the limits of the claim hereby located and have this the first day of January 1898 under and in accordance with the Revised Statutes of the United States located fifteen hundred linear feet of this vein or lode in length, with surface ground, three hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said lode, situated in the St. Helens Mining District, Clatsop County and State of Washington and known as the Sweden Mining Claim, and extending fifteen hundred feet to and from this notice at the discovery or prospect shaft; the exterior boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or prominent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the end line of the North East Discovery Claim of the Norway Lode about 20 feet North West of the discovery on Lake Canyon bank about $\frac{1}{2}$ of a mile above the mouth of said creek and about 75 feet above the Spirit Lake trail where it crosses the creek, the claim runs 1500 feet in a South Easterly direction and 300 feet on each side of center of said claim or lode and that intend to hold and work said above-described claim as provided by the local laws, and the customs and rules of mines and mining statutes and laws of the United States discovered on the ground.
