Notice of Lien.

Notice is hereby given that Ed. Williams of Clarke County, Washington claims a lien upon the franchise, earnings, and upon the real and personal property of the Fir Lumber Manufacturing Company, a corporation, the owner above named, which franchise, earnings, real and personal property was and is used in the operation of a saw mill of the said owner, to the full extent of all moneys due him from said Fir Lumber Manufacturing Company, a corporation, for labor performed by him within six months next preceding the filing of this claim therefor as follows:

The demand which is made by said Ed. Williams from said Fir Lumber Manufacturing Company, a corporation, owner, is for the sum of forty-five (45) dollars and twenty (20) cents after deducting all just credits and offsets.

The name of the person employing this claimant is H. F. Kavelage who was and is the president of said Fir Lumber Manufacturing Company, a corporation, who in so employing claimant acted for and on behalf of said corporation.

The terms and conditions of said employment were that said Ed. Williams was to perform work, labor and services for the above named owner in the operation of their saw mill situated at Wacomac in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, as a "Bull Cook" so called, at the compensation of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per month.

That claimant began work as aforesaid on the 1st day of July 1918 and the date of the cessation of his services was July 22nd 1918.

That the agreed wage of said claimant for said work was one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per month.

That said claim is made for said sum for work done between said 1st day of July and said 22nd day of July 1918, both inclusive.

The property in which this lien is filed and the franchise and earnings thereof and all the real and personal property of said owner upon which this claimant claims a lien and upon which this lien is filed, is situated in Skamania County, State of Washington, and this claim is filed for security for the wages for the work above referred to and covers the saw mill of said owner known as T.L. Fir Lumber Manufacturing Company mill, located at Cascades (Wacomac Post Office) in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, the machinery, tools and appurtenances thereto adjoining and used in connection therewith, together with all lumber, ties, timber and wood located and being at said mill and on the platform and yard thereof, and aboard cars on the siding adjacent thereto, and on all the earnings and other property, both real and personal, of said Fir Lumber Manufacturing Company, a corporation, which was used in the operation of said mill and all the business thereof during the period of employment of said claimant for which claim is hereby filed to the full extent of said sum of forty-five dollars and twenty cents (\$45.20) which is due him from said Fir Lumber Manufacturing Company.
