

"Evening Star" Claim. Copper Creek Mining District.

Notice of Location of Querty Claim.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, a citizen of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years, on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of June 1899, discovered a vein or lode of Querty or sand rock in place bearing Gold, Silver and Lead, within the limits of the claim hereby located, and have this 15<sup>th</sup> day of June 1899, under and in accordance with the Revised Statutes of the United States, located fifteen hundred linear feet of this vein or lode in length, with surface ground, three hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said lode, situated on the Copper Creek Mining District, County of Okanogan and State of Washington and known as the Evening Star Mining Claim, and extending fifteen hundred feet to and from this notice at the discovery or prospect shaft; the exterior boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at Shaft & Notice & running 500 ft N.W. to N.W. Corner. Thence 1500 S.W. to S.W. corner. Thence 600 ft S.E. to S.E. corner. Thence 1500 ft N.E. to N.E. corner. Thence 300 ft N.W. to Shaft & notice. Said claim is situated in Sec 25 Township 4 North of range 5 East of the Walammette Meridian & is on the West side of Texas gulch about 1/2 mile from where the trail crosses the gulch, & about 1 1/2 mile West of Lookout Mountain. The shaft is on the East side of the gulch. The adjoining claims are Christmas Tree on the N.E. end & Uncle Sam on the North Side & the Morning on the South Side and that I intend to hold and work said above described claim as provided by the local laws, and the customs and rules of miners, and mining statutes and laws of the United States.
