Edw. Gibbons To Allen Turner

This Indenture made this 27<sup>th</sup> day of  
October in the year of our Lord 1890, between  
Edward Gibbons, of the County of Colarke  
and State of Washington, party of the  
first part, and Allen Turner of the same  
County and place, party of the second part  
Witnesseth:

That the said party of the first, for  
and in consideration of the sum of Five  
dollars, to him in hand paid by the said  
party of the second part, the receipt of  
which is hereby acknowledged, hath granted,  
bargained, sold, remise, released unto  
the said party of the second part, his  
heirs and assigns, the undivided one third  
interest in the "Silver Queen Lode" as  
located, surveyed, Recorded and held by  
the said party of the first part, situated  
in Texas Mining District, Skamania County,  
State of Washington, together with all the  
metals, ores, gold and silver bearing quartz  
rock and earth therein, and all the rights  
privileges thereto incident, or in anywise  
appertaining: To have and to hold the said  
premises, together with the appurtenances  
thereto belonging, to the said party of the  
second part, his heirs and assigns forever.
