

Deed - Sisters of Charity to Pluma H. Mackey.

This Indenture made this 25th day of March 1887 by and between "The Sisters of Charity of Providence St. Vincent's Hospital, a Corporation existing and duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Oregon," the party of the first part, and Pluma H. Mackey of Skamania County, in the Territory of Washington, the party of the second part. Witnesseth:

That whereas heretofore Wm E. Thomas and Henry Wick, held a joint deed of the following described tracts of land, situated and lying in the said County of Skamania to wit: The [N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$] North East Quarter of the [N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ North West Quarter of Section [6.] Six in Township number (1) one North of Range (6) six East. Containing (40) forty acres; and also that other parcel of land situate in said Skamania County, known and described as the (W. $\frac{1}{2}$) West half of the (N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$) North East Quarter, and Lots (1) one and (2) two of Section (6) six in said Township number (1) one North of Range (6) East. Containing (151) one hundred and fifty-one acres. both of said described tracts making (191) one hundred and ninety-one acres. And whereas heretofore the said Wm E. Thomas and Henry Wick agreed upon a division of the above described tracts of land, by a line commencing at a point on the North line of Section (6) six, in the County, Townships and Range above named, (20) Twenty Rods and (17) seventeen links West of the North East Corner of the (N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$) North East Quarter, of Section number (6) six in Township number (1) one North of Range (6) six East in said Skamania County; Thence running in a in a South Easterly direction, keeping the center of the canyon to the mouth, and continuing the same to the cascade road, Thence
