

"Columbia View" Mining Claim.

Know all men by these presents, That I the undersigned, have this 18th day of July 1899, claimed by right of discovery and location 1500 feet linear and horizontal measurement in length, and 500 feet width on the Sea Lion Lode along the West Course or Strike thereof, 1300 feet of said claim, lying and being on the East Slope of the Mountain West of the discovery shaft of the Sea Lion, with all dips, spurs and variations and angles, said claim being more particularly described as follows:

Situated on the East Slope of the Mountain Ridge lying West of the East Fork of the North Fork of the Washougal River above the Quartz Claim of Leo Groub, known as the Cattemangus Claim, and the adjacent Quartz Claim of W. B. Wells, known as the Lizzie Murphy Claim; and being a Westerly Extension of the Sea Lion Claim belonging to L. G. Higgins; and extending from the West End of said Sea Lion Claim 1300 feet to the summit of the Divide between the East and West Forks of the North Fork of the Washougal River, and thence 200 feet West along the West Slope of the Mountain.

The name of this claim is the "Columbia View" boundaries marked by posts planted at the corners and at center side points.
