To all to whom these presents shall come  
Greeting:

Whereas, Harriett M. Johnson, of Pierce  
County, Washington Territory has deposited  
in the General Land Office of the United  
States a certificate of the Register of the  
Land Office at Vancouver, Washington Territory  
whereby it appears that full payment has  
been made by the said Harriett M. John-  
son, according to the provisions of the Act  
of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled  
"An Act making further provision for the sale  
of the Public Lands"; and the acts supplemen-  
tal thereto for the lots numbered one two  
and three and the South West quarter of the  
of the North East quarter of Section sixteen  
Township two North of Range six East, of  
Willamette Meridian, in Washington Ter-  
ritory, containing one hundred and sixty  
two acres, and thirty-five hundredths of  
an acre, according to the Official Plat of the  
Survey of the said lands returned to the Gen-  
eral Land Office by the Surveyor General  
which said tract has been purchased by the  
said Harriett M. Johnson.

Now Know Ye That the United States  
of America, in consideration of the premises,  
and in conformity with the several Acts of  
Congress, in such case made and provided,  
have given and granted, and by these presents  
do give and grant unto the said Harriett  
M. Johnson and to her heirs, the said tract  
above described, To have and to hold the  
same, together with all the rights, privileges  
immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever  
nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Harriett  
M. Johnson, and to her heirs and assigns forever,  
subject to any vested and accrued water rights
