

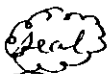
Warranty Deed

Know all men by these presents that Ellen J Wallis of Port Ludlow. W.T. whose former name was Ellen J McNaught and resided at Cascades Wash Terr. and her husband Wm Wallis of Port Ludlow Wash Terr. in consideration of seventy five (\$75.00) Dollars to us paid by Thomas Moffett of Cascades Wash Terr. do hereby remise release convey and warrant to said Thomas Moffett and unto his heirs and assigns all our right Title and Interest in and to the following described parcel of real estate situate in Cascades County of Kamania W. Indian Territory to wit Commencing at the bank of the Columbia river east of what is known as the Old Garrison as a point that separates the Donation Land Claim of B B Bishop from the Donation Land Claim of Geo H Johnson. and commencing on said dividing line and running North Thirteen and one fourth ($13\frac{1}{4}$) rods thence East Thirteen and one fourth ($13\frac{1}{4}$) rods thence South to the Columbia river thence West to the place of Beginning here forming one acre more or less. Excepting however a piece of forty feet square. is hereby reserved by Ellen J Wallis said forty feet. To form a square around that part where the grave of her late husband Thos McNaught is situated and Tombstone to be the Center of said piece reserved.

We have and to hold the same together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto in anywise appertaining to the said Thomas Moffett his heirs and assigns and that we the said Ellen J. and Wm Wallis will warrant and defend the same to the said Thos as Moffett. and to his heirs and assigns forever in witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seal this first day of October A.D. 1886.
