NOTICE OF CLAIM OF LIEN
OF LABORER OR MATERIAL MAN.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 12th day of July 1918, at the request of the superintendent of said company, Mr. Kalvalege, the above named claimant commenced to perform labor upon (or furnish material for) that certain building or structure consisting of a road bed for a logging railroad situated upon the following described land, to-wit:

Begin at a point 14.32 South and 23.22 East of Section Corner of Sections 16, 17, 20, 21, Township 2 North, Range 7 East W. M., said point being 40 feet from the S. P. & S. right of way, and also at County Road x marked by 3/4 inch iron pipe or stake and running North 47° 10', West 1022 St. to a point on State Road #8 and marked by 1/2 inch rod, thence South 86°, West 635 feet, thence North 45° West 355 feet, thence South 44° 50', West 40 feet, thence South 40° 15', East 1190 feet, thence South 45° 25', East 308 feet, thence in an Easterly direction on a line 40 feet from the S. P. & S. Railway to place of beginning. Containing 16.3 acres, all in Skamania County, State of Washington.

Also all of the right of way occupied by that certain logging road of the Fir Lumber Manufacturing Company, a corporation, lying and being between the above described property of said company and that certain tract of land and timber known as the Davis McRae Tract in Skamania County, Washington, in Skamania County, State of Washington.

Of which property said Fir Lumber Manufacturing Company, a corporation, was and is the owner or reputed owner

The performance of which labor (or the furnishing of which material) ceased on the 19th day of August, 1918.

That all of said land hereinabove described is necessary for the convenient use and occupation of the said building or structure; that said labor performed, (or material furnished) was of the value of Three Hundred Seventy Dollars; that ninety (90) days have not elapsed since said last named date.

For which labor (or material) the claimant, undersigned, claims a lien upon the property herein described and the buildings situated thereon for the said sum of Three Hundred Seventy Dollars the same being for 37 days work at the agreed price of \$10.00 per day.
