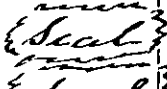
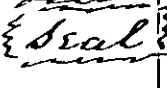


To have and to hold the above granted and described premises unto him the said Malcom Dobie, and unto his heirs and assigns forever.

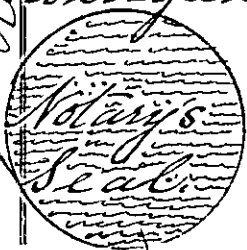
